## SELECTION PROCESS

KOI will do a merit-based review on each application. With the recommendation of a Selection Committee comprising of the Academic Manager, Admission Manager, and Vice President (Student Affairs), KISS will be awarded to eligible students who have demonstrated academic excellence in their previous studies.

The decision of the KOI Committee will be final. The Processing time is between 2-4 working days.

## HOW TO APPLY

1. Read the Scholarship criteria and term and conditions - only apply if you are meeting the eligibility criteria
2. Complete the KOI international student application form
3. Attach all educational documents (onshore / overseas) to support your scholarship request.
4. KOI Admissions will assess your education documents for eligibility.
5. Your offer letter (page 2) will specify whether you have been granted the KISS scholarship.
6. Scholarship applications will **not** be considered after the Census Date of the intake.

### \*Terms and Conditions

Quotas may be applicable. Scholarships are only awarded to students who meet the Eligibility Criteria. This award will be applied to applicable courses only unless advised otherwise. KOI reserves the right to offer scholarships at its sole discretion. KOI reserves the right to withdraw a scholarship offer where the student has not yet accepted the offer or has not enrolled in the course by the date specified in the Offer Letter. If you do not meet the ongoing conditions to maintain the scholarship, the scholarship will be ended. KOI reserves the right to amend the terms and conditions of the KOI International Student Scholarship at any time.

### Eligibility (Onshore)

You must have a passing record of 100% with your most recent provider.

**example: attempted four (4) units at HEEd institute/university and passed all four (4)**

Your previous provider must be a higher education institute or university. Your proposed studies at KOI must be of the same AQF level.

Qualification from VET providers are **not** applicable.

### Eligibility Offshore (Undergraduate)

- 1 - You must have achieved a Higher Secondary (year 12) result of a minimum 70% or an equivalent CGPA in previous study
- 2 - You must have achieved an IELTS / PTE or an equivalent score of overall 6.5 or more

### Eligibility Offshore (Postgraduate)

- 1 - You must have achieved a Bachelor qualification with a minimum of 60% or an equivalent CGPA in previous study
- 2 - You must have achieved an IELTS / PTE or an equivalent score of overall 7.0 or more.

### \*Ongoing conditions / requirements:

- All students must maintain 100% pass record for the scholarship to retain active.
- The scholarship is not transferable.
- Students must pay required tuition fees by relevant due dates.
- The scholarship remains valid for students on an approved Leave of Absence for one trimester only.
- Scholarship applications will not be considered after the Census Date of the intake
- Successful applicants must also agree to act as student ambassador for KOI Society and support promotional activities.
- All students must satisfy the academic and English requirements for admission as specified by KOI for the respective course. [Click here](#) to learn more.
